WELCOME TO THE FIRST EDITION

This summer the La Grange Park Public Library will begin a construction project to repair structural damage primarily on the east and west walls and make several exterior improvements.

Library staff first noticed water damage along the east wall in 2014. After a water infiltration

study was completed in spring of 2015, the board of trustees began extensive, multi-year research to determine the scope of various maintenance issues related to the building.

La Grange Park Public Library Building Project FAQs



Question:

How are you paying for the project? Will there be a referendum?

Answer:

We've budgeted carefully for the last 6 years since we first learned of the issues with the exterior and we've been able to put \$1.5 million in our capital savings fund. The rest will come from debt service we will issue during the summer. This does not increase taxes and we pay it off like any other loan over the course of a certain amount of years.

Question:

Will this affect traffic on La Grange Rd?

Answer:

We do not believe this will have any affect on La Grange Rd traffic. If anything, there may be a few trucks pulling in and out of Oak Avenue as workers arrive and then leave later in the day. However, no work is being done that will involve road closures or increased traffic.

Question:

Will you be closing the library during construction?

Answer:

We do not anticipate any extended closures during construction.

Question:

When will construction start and what hours will work be taking place?

Answer:

We anticipate construction beginning in July 2021 to take advantage of warm weather. Hours of heavy work will likely be completed in the morning and early afternoon.

La Grange Park Public Library History of the Building Project



July 2015

Kluber Architects & Engineers completes an investigative study after water is found coming into the library; cost estimates reported at approximately \$2.2 million



February 2016

Studio GC is hired to complete a Facility Needs Assessment to determine the full scope of maintenance needed in addition to water infiltration issues



July 2017

A community meeting is held to share the Facility Assessment with residents



June 2018

A second community meeting is held to answer questions about the facility and share the new Master Facility Plan



July 2020

Library board issues a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for Construction Management services; Boldt is hired as the library's CM firm



November 2020

RFQ for Architectural services is issued



January 2021

Public meeting held to discuss architect selection. 845 Design Group is selected as the most qualified design firm.



February 2021

845 Design solicits community input on the building project including a patron survey, Zoom interviews with community members, and staff and board discussions.


