



This is my library- the La Grange Park Public Library.



When I walk into the library, I make sure to use my quiet voice.




I can visit the library with my parents, caregiver, or a friend. I always stay with them.






I can take either the stairs or the elevator down to the Children's Department.




Here is the Children's Department desk! I am free to ask a librarian for help if I need it.




I can do all kinds of fun activities in the Children's Department. I can also check things out to use at home or in the library.

The catalog tells me what is available for me to check out. If I am looking for a title, I can find it here. I can also ask a librarian to help me find anything.






When I am ready to check out, I can use my library card with a librarian at the desk or at the self check-out station. There are self check-out stations on every floor.

When I am done with an activity box I should bring it back to the librarian at the desk.






Wonderbooks look like regular books, except they have a speaker that reads the words aloud to me.



If I want to know about any fun classes or programs, I can pick up a calendar on the wall across from the desk.




Even if I don't want to check anything out, there is still so much to do at the library. I can...

...color or do a craft!




...look at the fish!





...play with blocks, Legos, puzzles, dinosaurs, and more.




There are a few different rooms in the Children's Department.







There is a family restroom near the fish tank, and two bigger restrooms in back of the department.




There is a Quiet Room around the corner. If I need some alone time I can ask a librarian if I can use the Quiet Room.




The Activity Room is near the Quiet Room. If I come to the library for a program, it is likely that it will be in the Activity Room.



If my program is not in the Activity Room, it might be in the Mary Lou Hurley Community Room upstairs.




When I am ready to leave the Children's Department, I can take the stairs or the elevator to the main floor.
